Greetings to all!!!

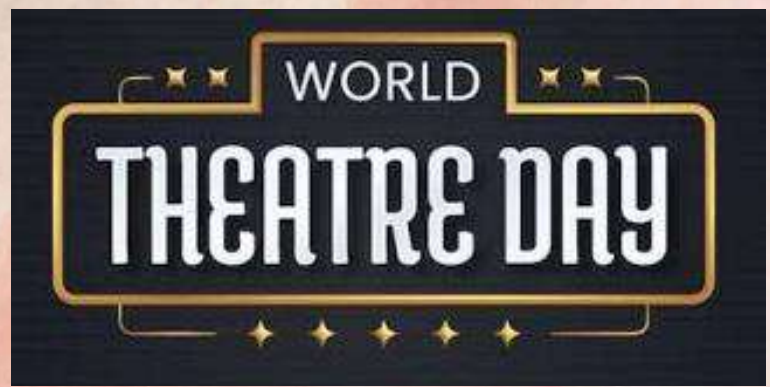
