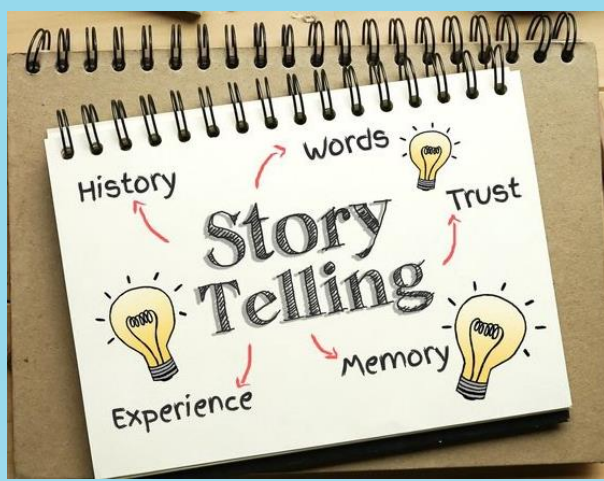
To mark World Water Day, our school held a special assembly where our young environmental champions came together to raise awareness about water conservation.

Through bright colors, expressive drawings, and thoughtful slogans, the students reminded us how essential it is to cherish and protect every drop of water.

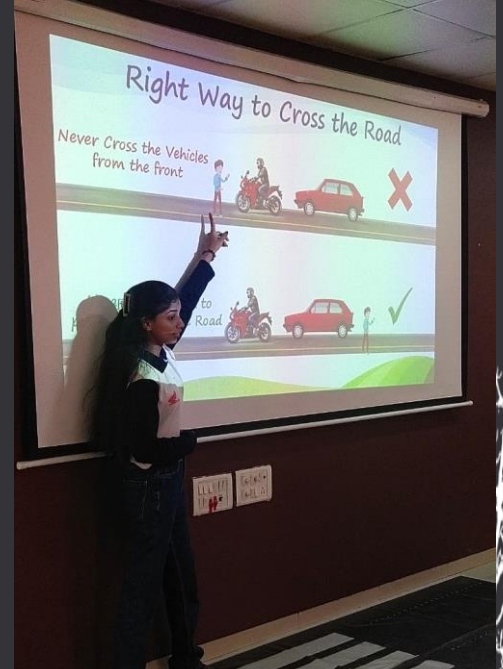
As part of the assembly, the children took a heartfelt Water Conservation Pledge, promising to use water wisely, avoid wastage, and encourage others to do the same.



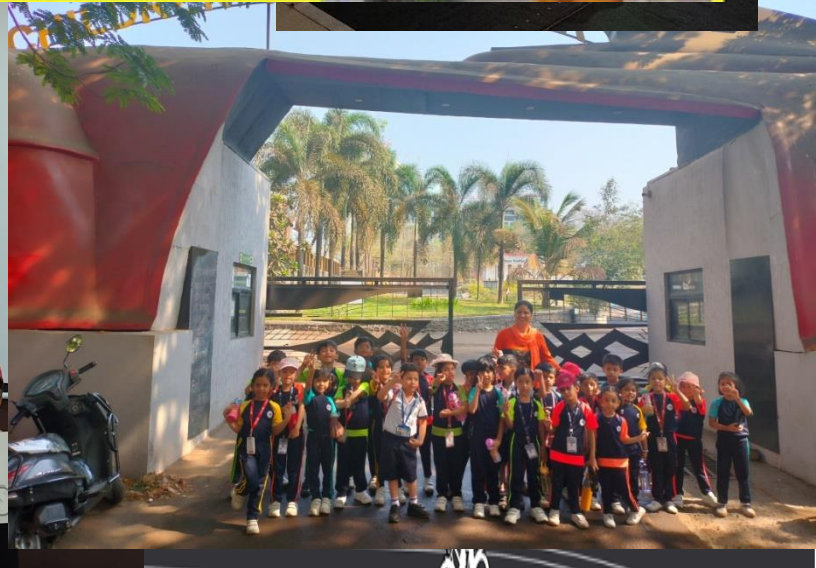

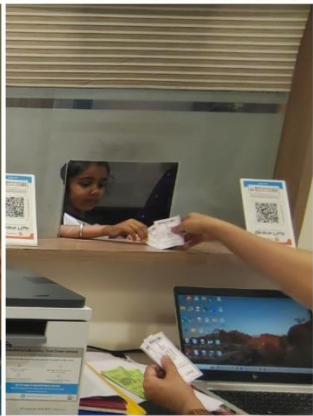


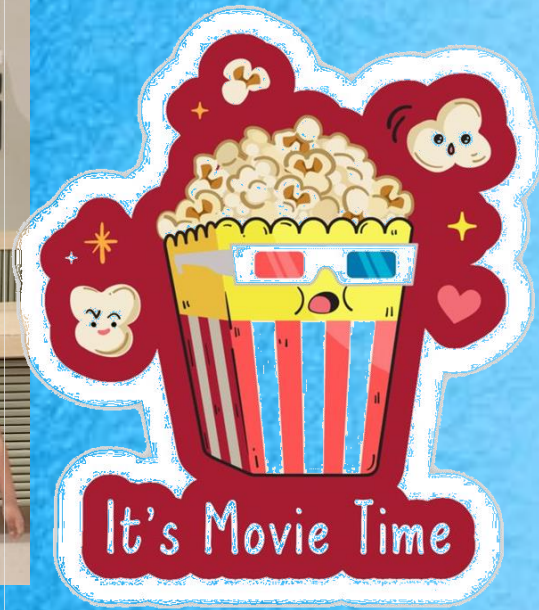
"Dentists Make the World a Better Place... One Smile at a Time!"

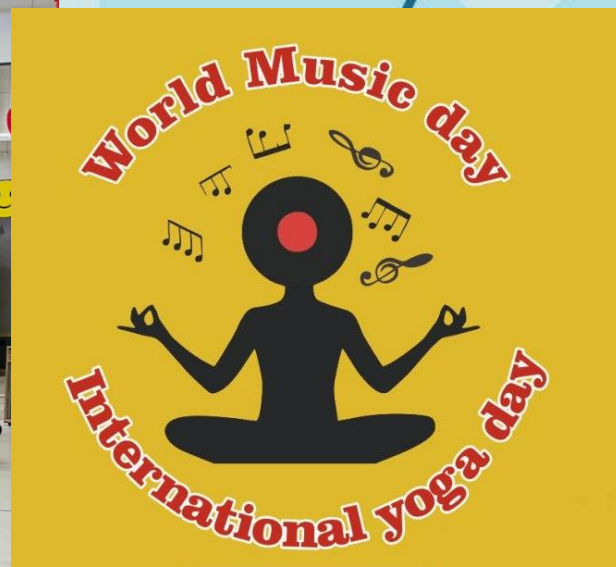
Yoga Day was a beautiful blend of movement, mindfulness, and magic!
